NPTC Level 2 Certificate of Competence in Chainsaw maintenance and cross cutting	This 2-day course, formerly known as CS30, provides students with a thorough understanding of chainsaw maintenance and safe operation as well as the cross cutting of timber. This course is delivered through both practical and theory sessions.	£444
NPTC Level 2 Award in the Safe Use of Brushcutters & Trimmers	This 1-day course will teach students how to carry out pre-start checks and maintenance. Selection of cutting heads and operation techniques for brushcutter and trimmers.	£278
NPTC Level 2 Certificate of Competence in Felling Small Trees up to 380mm	This practical 4-day course, formerly known as CS31, builds on the knowledge gained in the chainsaw maintenance and cross cutting course. After successful completion, students will be able to safely fell and process small trees up to 380mm in diameter.	£728
NPTC Level 2 Certificate of Competence in Tree climbing and aerial rescue	Formally known as CS38, you will learn about knots and harnesses, safe climbing techniques and aerial rescue including pole rescue, this course is 5 days.	£794
NPTC Level 2 CoC in Manually Fed Wood Chippers	This 1day course covers the use of manually fed wood chippers, (including tracked chippers), covering pre-use checks and maintenance, identification of controls and instruments, operating the machine to chip material appropriate to the capacity of the machine, and hitching and unhitching of the machine. PA1 NPTC	This 1day course precedes all other pesticide courses. This is the foundation module that places a strong emphasis upon using pesticides safely. This course will cover legislation, necessary precautions, storage, record keeping and environmental protection.	£232
PA2 NPTC	This 2 day course covers legislation, preparation and maintenance of the sprayer, as well as nozzle selection, calibration and safe operation. The training will be based on the use of a tractor mounted Boom Sprayer.	£558
PA3 NPTC	This course will cover legislation, preparation and maintenance of the sprayer, as well as nozzle selection, calibration and safe operation. The training will be based on the use of a tractor mounted Air Assisted Sprayer.	£432
PA6A NPTC (Knapsack sprayer)	This course enables students to prepare and use hand held pesticides applicators. Including nozzle selection, calibration and safe operation.	£432

NPTC Level 2 Certificate of Competence in the Safe Use & Responsible Use of Veterinary Medicines (Cattle & Sheep)	This qualification provides candidates with the necessary skills and knowledge to provide basic treatment to Cattle and Sheep . It covers health & safety, legislation relating to the use of Veterinary Medicines, signs of health and ill health in various species, safe and correct procedures for administering Veterinary Medicines and the procedures for monitoring the animal's response and the actions to take in the case of an emergency. NPTC Livestock Transport Certificate (Short journeys)	If you are involved in the transportation of animals by road on short journeys (over 65km and up to 8 hours duration) this course will ensure you meet the requirement for a Certificate of Competence The qualification is species specific (e.g. cattle, sheep, goats, pigs, poultry, horses, game birds). It covers the legal requirements, journey planning, vehicle suitability, fitness to travel, causes and signs of stress in animals, space allowances, stocking densities, handling and animal welfare in transit and post journey requirements.
