 Use of pesticides is governed by the Food and Environment Protection Act 1985 (FEPA), the Provision and Use of Work Equipment Regulations 1998 (PUWER) and the Control of Substances Hazardous to Health Regulations 1999 (COSHH).

How to find us



From London Luton Airport (LTN).

Distance to Lely, St. Neots, is 31 miles and approximately 60 minutes by car. A free shuttle bus connects the airport with Luton Parkway Station. From Parkway, trains run frequently to London King's Cross (journey time approximately 35 minutes) where you can get a connecting train to St. Neots.

By train. From London King's Cross, take a First Connect train to St. Neots. The journey

takes approximately 50 minutes. Lely is 100 yards from St. Neots' train station.

By car. From the A1, take the A428 following signs for Cambridge. At the first roundabout, continue on the A428. Follow the A428 over another roundabout (take second exit), and turn left at the next roundabout (take first exit). Follow the road down under the railway bridge and Lely is on the right.
